**Subject: Imposition of Penalty on Sh. Chemet Nurbo, Patwari - regarding.**

**ORDER No. 51 /Adm of 2014.**

**D A T E D : 17 -05- 2014.**

1. Whereas, Smt. Yangskit Dolma D/o Late Tsetan Puntsog R/o Henaskut filed a complaint, before the Deputy Commissioner, Leh, against Sh. Chemet Nurboo, Patwari of SDM Office, Nubra regarding sale of a land of Tibetan Settlement measuring 1 kanal at Choglamsar for an amount of Rs. 1.00 lacs by executing a sale agreement with the above said complainant, which actually belonged to some one else; and
2. Whereas, an inquiry was contemplated against Sh. Chemet Nurboo, regarding the above said case/application, which was of serious nature and vide this office order No. 395 of 2013 dated: 11.10.2013, Sh. Chemet Nurboo, Patwari, was placed under suspension for violation of JK Employees Conduct Rules, 1971; and
3. Whereas, a charge sheet containing "Articles of Charge" alongwith statement of imputations was served upon Sh. Chemet Nurboo, vide this office order No. DC-32(M)E/2013(704) Dated 26.10.2013, and requiring him to furnish his written statement of defence; and
4. Whereas the charged official furnished his reply on 09.11.2013; and
5. Whereas, the Competent Authority deemed it appropriate to further inquire into the charges levelled against Sh. Chemet Nurboo, and as such Smt. Zahida Bano, KAS (ACD Leh), was appointed as the Inquiry Officer vide this office Order No. 01/Adm of 2014 dated: 06.01.2014 to inquire into the charges levelled against Sh. Chemet Nurboo, Patwari. Sh. Gurmet Namgial, Tehsildar, Leh was appointed as the Presiding Officer; and
6. Whereas, the Inquiry Officer submitted her enquiry report with necessary documents on 03.03.2014; and
7. Whereas, perusal of the inquiry report revealed that being a Government Servant (Patwari), Sh. Chemet Nurboo misused his official position and sold a piece of state land (of Tibetan Settlement) violating Rule-3 of Govt. Employees Conduct Rules; and
8. Whereas, the Competent Authority again (Deputy Commissioner) referred the matter back to the Inquiry Officer for further enquiring by summoning the complainant (who was the key witness of the case); and

9. Whereas, the Inquiry Officer again submitted the final inquiry report on 11.03.2014 with necessary documents which clearly revealed that Sh. Chemet Nurbo, Patwari has repeatedly indulged in buying and selling of land allotted to Tibetan Settlements, which cannot be sold as per rules; and
10. Whereas, the competent decided to imposed the penalty of dismissal upon Sh. Nurboo and as such, a provisional notice was served upon Sh. Chemet Nurboo, patwari to explain as to why he should not be dismissed from the service of the state under rule 30(viii) of J&K Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956;
11. Whereas, he replied to the above said notice on 24.3.3014 alongwith an agreement of settlement between him & the complainant and pleaded guilty; and
12. Whereas, the undersigned personally summoned the complainant on 10.4.2014 and she mentioned that she has been made good her monetary loss by the Patwari and she urged upon the undersigned not to dismiss the charged official.
13. Now therefore, in view of the above paragraphs, it is hereby ordered that though the complainant agrees to withdraw her complaint against the charged official, however, the Patwari still remains guilty of violating the conduct rules. As such, the following minor penalties are ordered to be imposed upon him in terms of Rule 30 of CCA rules:-
- Imposition of one month's salary as fine.
  - Withholding of two annual increments with immediate effect.
14. It is further ordered that he shall be reinstated in service with immediate effect and all his period of suspension shall be treated as on duty.
